### Overview

As part of the International Olympiad on Astronomy and Astrophysics (IOAA) 2025 outreach initiative, we invite college students across India to participate in two national-level online competitions. These contests aim to celebrate astronomical imagination and design while building connections between science, visual storytelling, and communication.

# 1. Competition Categories

#### A. Cosmic Canvas (Digital Illustration Contest)

Participants must submit an original, digitally created illustration based on one of the following themes related to space and astronomy.

#### Themes (choose any one):

- Bhartiya Space Station
- Black Holes and Space-Time
- Exoplanets and Cosmic Neighbours
- Space Colonization
- India in Astronomy: A Vision for 2050

Entries must be created using digital art tools. Only one entry per participant is allowed.

Please make sure to read the full terms and conditions before submitting your entry.

#### B. Stellar Stories (One-Page Digital Comic Contest)

Participants must submit a four-panel static digital comic strip based on any astronomyrelated theme. The comic should creatively engage viewers and be suitable for Instagram.

- Themes can be narrative, informative, educational, or speculative.
- Any visual style is permitted—colour or black & white, sketch, line art, or vector.

- The comic must be static (no animation or interactivity).
- Format must follow the aspect ratio suitable for full visibility on Instagram.
- Text and visuals should be clearly readable.

Please make sure to read the full terms and conditions before submitting your entry.

# 2. Eligibility

- Participants must be currently enrolled in an undergraduate or postgraduate degree program at a recognised college or university in India.
- Each participant may submit only one entry per competition.

## 3. Submission Guidelines

- Entries must be posted on Instagram by the participant.
- The official Instagram handle **@ioaa.2025** must be followed.
- The post caption must include:
  - Participant's full name
  - Name of college and course
  - City and state
  - Competition hashtag: #CosmicCanvas or #StellarStories
  - Hashtag: #IOAA2025
- Deadline: All entries must be posted on or before 30 June 2025.

### 4. Selection Process

- A fixed number of entries receiving the highest number of public likes will be shortlisted.
- In case of tied like counts, all tied entries will be included in the shortlist.
- A panel of professionals will select the top three entries in each competition based on:
  - Artistic quality and creativity
  - Relevance to the astronomical theme
  - Visual communication and clarity
- Entries outside the shortlisted group will not be considered.

# 5. Prizes and Opportunities

- Winners (First, Second, and Third) in each category will receive:
  - Certificates of Recognition
  - Cash prize
- Selected entries may also be featured in:
  - IOAA 2025 newsletters and websites
  - Educational posters, bookmarks, banners, postcards, and event backdrops
  - Exhibitions, social media, and outreach campaigns (with full credit to the artist)
- Participants demonstrating exceptional design or storytelling skills may also be considered for future creative collaboration opportunities with the IOAA 2025 Design and Outreach Team.

### 6. Terms and Conditions

- Submissions must reflect the participant's creative effort and originality. While reference materials may be used for inspiration, the final composition must be their own.
- Use of AI-generated content, direct copying, or submission of work created by someone else is strictly prohibited and will result in disqualification.
- Misrepresentation of authorship, affiliation, or use of uncredited third-party assets will not be tolerated.
- Group or collaborative entries are not allowed. Only individual submissions will be accepted.
- By participating, students agree that their submitted entries may be showcased, with full credit, in IOAA 2025-related educational and outreach materials—such as newsletters, exhibitions, bookmarks, banners, or event displays. These uses will be non-commercial and solely intended to celebrate and promote student creativity.
- The organisers reserve the right to revise, suspend, or withhold awards based on quality or eligibility concerns.
- All decisions made by the judging panel and organising committee will be final and binding.
