# Observation Examination Sky Map Round



#### Instructions

Page 1 of 1

- You are given an envelope marked B. Please verify the Contestant Code printed on it.
- The Question Paper, two Sky Maps, and Summary Answersheets are kept inside the smaller envelope S. You are allowed to open this envelope (S) only when the whistle is blown to mark the start of the examination. The exam time (1 hour) starts from this point.

### • Writing your answers:

#### 1. Summary Answersheet:

- For each question a separate Summary Answersheet has been provided. Write your contestant code on each page of the Summary Answersheet.
- Final answer(s) for each question / each part of a question must be written in the corresponding box in the Summary Answersheet.

### 2. Sky Maps:

- Please write your contestant code on each Map.
- For marking / writing on the Maps, you must use a dark pencil.

## 3. Working Sheets:

- Your detailed work, if any, must be shown on the Working Sheet.
- Both sides of the Working Sheet should be used. Write only inside the boxed area.
  Write your Contestant Code on both sides of each Working Sheet.
- Start a new question on a fresh Working Sheet. Write the question number in the box provided at the top.

## • At the end of the examination:

- Check that you have correctly written your Contestant Code and page numbers on all used sheets.
- Arrange your sheets in the following way:
  Summary Answersheet of each question (starting with OM01) followed by the corresponding sky map, and any Working Sheet(s) used for that question.
- Similarly stack the Summary Answersheet, sky map, and any Working Sheet(s) used for each question, in sequence.
- Place the bunch of all your used sheets arranged in the above manner inside the smaller envelope S. All Summary Answersheets and sky maps must be placed inside the envelope S irrespective of whether you have used them or not.
- Only the contents of the smaller envelope [S] will be evaluated. Any sheet that is not placed inside this envelope will not be evaluated.
- Place the smaller envelope S inside the bigger envelope B.
- All other sheets, namely, Instruction Sheet(s), Question Paper(s), Data Sheet(s) and unused
  Working Sheet(s) should be placed directly inside the bigger envelope B.
- Tie the thread seal on the envelope B.
- Hand over the envelope B to the examiner. Make sure that no sheet is left on the table.
